

COOKIES POLICY

This cookies policy is part of the Privacy Policy of Arzalia Ediciones, S. L. website (hereafter, "ARZALIA") hosted under the domain www.arzalia.com (hereafter the "WEBSITE") or under any of the sub domains or web pages therein.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small piece of data that is downloaded to your computer when you access a website. Cookies allow the WEBSITE to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of the user or their computer, and depending on the information they contain and the way in which their computer is used, they can be used to recognize the user. Its usefulness is that the WEBSITE is able to remember visits from users when they return to browse its pages.

Why cookies are used?

We use cookies because they allow us to obtain more information about your use of the WEBSITE and its contents, helping us to improve your experience on future visits.

In short, cookies allow us to respond to users as individuals, adapting their operations to their needs or tastes and remember the information about their preferences.

What excludes the use of cookies?

We do not store potentially identifiable data such as addresses, passwords, credit or debit card data, etc., in the cookies we use.

Types of cookies

Following the guidelines of the Spanish Data Protection Agency we proceed to detail the use of cookies made by the WEBSITE in order to inform as accurately as possible.

This website uses the following **own cookies**:

- *Session cookies*, to ensure that users who may post comments are human and not automated applications. This is how spam is battled.

This website uses the following **third party cookies**:

- Google Analytics: stores cookies in order to compile statistics on the traffic and volume of visits to the website. By using the WEBSITE, you consent to Google's processing of your information. Therefore, the exercise of any right in this regard should be addressed by directly contacting Google.

- Social Networks: Each social network uses its own cookies to make it possible to click on "Like" or "Share" buttons.

How to uninstall, block or delete cookies?

The user can allow, block or delete cookies installed on the computer by setting the options of the corresponding browser. If you do not allow the installation of cookies in your browser, you may not be able to access any of the WEBSITE's sections.

Below is a detailed help to configure cookies depending on the browser you use.
